Bring a new song about money. It could be funny, use money makes the world go round, or use money talks.

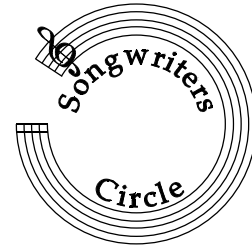
May Song Challenge - Gimme a Fiver
